Luke 10:25-37

Main Idea: Look for opportunities to be generous to your neighbor this week.

2. Pray and ask God to reveal your unseen neighbors. List as many ways you can to be a neighbor to one of these unseen neighbors.
3. Read the following quote and evaluate the Priest and the Levite in light of it; “It doesn't matter how well you know the Bible, what matters is how well you apply what you know.” Now evaluate yourself in light of the quote.
4. List some ways you could be generous with your time.
5. List your top three talents. Ask God to show you how you can be generous with those talents?
6. What other individuals from the Bible were generous with time, talent and treasure?
